Camp Nurse Job Description

Overall

- Oversee camp medical needs
- Position runs from the last week of June until the last week of August. See calendar for specific dates.

Qualifications

- College graduate of at least 21 years old for overnight camp
- Certification for Massachusetts as either a Registered Nurse (RN), Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN), Paramedic, or certification of a higher degree.
- Have a desire to develop skills related to camp and working with children in the natural environment.
- Applicants must be willing to work a flexible schedule, live full-time in a residential camp setting for at least two weeks.

During Camp

- Ensure that all campers health and safety needs are met
- Keep infirmary stocked with necessary first aid supplies and OTC medications.
- Manage all medical forms for campers and staff
- Oversee health check-in on Sunday and meet with parents to discuss any health concerns
- Oversee medication management of all campers ensuring they receive the necessary doses of medications
- Ensure all first aid kits at various program areas are stocked
- Manage all allergies of campers/counselor and ensure that cook is aware of any food allergies
- Hours: The nurse stays on camp in the infirmary from Sunday at 10AM until Friday at 8PM
